EXAMINATION PREPARATIONS FOR PATIENTS

Please note that some examinations, including interventional radiology require special preparation. Please check when making your appointment.

Cardiac CT: No food prior to appointment, unless diabetic. Maintain normal fluid intake. Take all regular medications with the **exceptions of Viagra, Levitra & Cialis (cease 5 days prior to scan).**

CT Angiography: No food prior to appointment, unless diabetic. Maintain normal fluid intake. Take all regular medications.

CT Brain, Spine or Extremities: No preparation required.

CT Neck or Chest: No food prior to appointment, unless diabetic. Maintain normal fluid intake. Take all regular medications.

CT Abdomen or Pelvis: No food prior to appointment, unless diabetic. Maintain normal fluid intake. Take all regular medications. Arrive one hour earlier for your appointment time to begin drinking oral contrast.

Angiogram: No food prior to appointment. Ask for special instructions about medications and post-procedural care.

MRI: No preparation. Wear soft comfortable clothing. MRI safety questionnaire **MUST** be completed.

Echocardiography, Transthoracic: Eat normally

Echocardiography, Transoesophageal: Fast 6 hours prior to appointment. Ask for specific instructions about medications and post-procedural care.

Mammography & Breast Biopsies: Do not wear deodorant or talcum powder to your appointment.

Ultrasound Pelvis & Urinary Tract: Empty bladder 2 hours prior to appointment time, then drink 1 Litre of water over the next hour. **Do not empty bladder after this.**

IVP, Barium studies, Ultrasound, Doppler and other examinations: Special preparations are required. Please ask for instructions about preparation and medications when making your appointment.

DIABETIC PATIENTS:

Medication: If you take ANY medication to control your diabetes, you must let us know when you are making your appointment. If special instructions are required for non ionic contrast procedures, a Radiology Nurse will contact you.

Well-controlled diabetes: For examinations requiring you to fast, book the earliest appointment possible, have a light breakfast and your morning medication afterwards.

Unstable/Insulin dependent diabetes: Continue your usual diet treatment and monitor your diabetes carefully if bowel preparation is required (e.g. barium enema, IVP).

IF YOU REQUIRE A CONTRAST INJECTION, PLEASE MONITOR YOUR DIABETES CAREFULLY FOR 48 HOURS AFTER YOUR EXAMINATION. CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU BECOME CONCERNED.
